CPVC -KITEC-PRESSFIT

CPVC = Chlorinated Polyvinyl Chloride




CPVC-KITEC-PRESSFIT

A flexible plastic & aluminum pipe used for hydronic heating



CPVC-KITEC-PRESSFIT

Stainless steel or copper pipes connected by “pressing” them together, fittings contain rubber gaskets or O rings



What is CPVC?

- Chlorinated Polyvinyl Chloride, or “CPVC” is a rigid plastic pipe used for potable water including supplying hot water.





What is the problem with CPVC?

- Embrittlement
- Discoloration
- Knit Line Fractures



- Pipes are marked: Kitec, PlumbBetter, IPEX AQUA, WarmRite, Kitec XPA, AmbioComfort, XPA, KERR Controls or Plomberie Améliorée. Fittings are marked: Kitec or KTC

PRESS FIT

Stainless steel or copper pipes connected by “pressing” them together, fittings contain rubber gaskets or O rings





Diagram of Grooved Coupling

A grooved coupling is comprised of four elements:

- the grooved pipe
- the gasket
- coupling housing
- the nuts and bolts



Press Fit/Grooved Connections

- Issues alleged relating to O rings and gaskets
 - Cracking
 - Softening
 - Discs in valves may exhibit same problems



Investigation and Repair Issues

- Initial identification
- Extractions
- Repairs



Statutes of Limitation Product Liability

RCW 7.72.060

- Useful Safe Life
- 12 Year Presumption
- 3 years from discovery



Class Action Considerations

- Yellow Brass Claims against Uponor arising out of F1807 fittings are settled
- National and state class actions relating to F1960 fittings are pending.
- Consider your legal options while you still have them.
